- ❖ Irene Lewis Park: 1/2-acre open space with a caboose display and water tower.
 - Annex Park: 1/10-acre space with picnic tables and two static railcar displays (Maximum Capacity is 75 people for both parks)



Rules and Regulations

- All fees and/or deposits are to be paid five working days prior to your event.
- All changes to your event will need to be made five days prior to your event.
- ◆ Approved returned deposits may take between 7 – 14 business days to be returned.
- The application form becomes your permit for facility use upon authorized approval and payment of all fees and/or deposits.
- Please check in with museum staff before and after your event.
- Park facilities must be left clean and in the same condition presented before your arrival.
- You may bring food, drinks, chairs, BBQ Canopies/EZ-ups no larger than 10x10, balloons, and a piñata to enjoy at our Annex & Irene Lewis Park.
- Vehicles may not enter the park to drop off or pick up any equipment (BBQs, tables & chairs, tents 10 x 10 only, etc.)
- ALCOHOL is STRICTLY PROHIBITED at all park facilities.

- Taco carts are allowed but must always be located outside during your event. Food trucks are not permitted.
- Balloon garlands need to be popped at the conclusion of your event and discarded in the trash can.
- Fun Jumpers, Bounce Houses, Trackless Trains, and Petting Zoos are STRICTLY PROHIBITED at all park facilities.
- Decorating is prohibited inside the museum.
- Eating and drinking is prohibited inside the museum, except for bottled water.
- Any vendor wishing to sell on city property will need to apply for special event permits.
